AWARD

This industrial dispute between M/s. Enterprising Engineers (Lion's Park, CPT Contractors' Colony, P.O. Durgachak, Haldia) under the Management of M/s. Renuka Sugar Ltd. Vill & P.O. Debhog, City Center, Dist. Purba Medinipur and Sri Labakumar Das, Vill. Mahatma Gandhi Nagar, P.O. Hatiberia, P.S. Haldia, Purba Medinipur, Pin - 721657 has been referred by the Govt. of West Bengal, Labour Department vide Order No. 659-IR/IR/11L-64/13, dated 21.05.2014, to this Tribunal for adjudication of the following issues: -

ISSUES(S)

Therefore, I am of the view that it is a fit case to pass a 'No Dispute Award' under Rule 22 of Industrial Disputes Rules, 1958, the industrial dispute by and between the parties being treated as non-existent.
