MEMORANDUM

Subject : Absorption of Attendants attached to Ministers in the State and Chief Govt. Whip, West Bengal Legislative Assembly in regular establishment.

The issue of amendments to the existing procedures for absorption of Attendants attached to the Ministers and Chief Govt. Whip, West Bengal Legislative Assembly in regular establishments of the Government has been under consideration of the Government for sometime. After careful consideration of the matter in all its aspects and in supersession of the relevant provisions contained in this Department No. 84(60)-Emp., dated 16-06-2004, the Government has been pleased to order as follows :-

- I. Attendants attached to Ministers/Ministers of State and Chief Govt. Whip, West Bengal Legislative Assembly, who have already completed at least one year of satisfactory continuous service, and are eligible to be considered for absorption in regular establishment of the State Government against vacancies in Group-'D' posts, in terms of Labour Department Memo. No. 680(150)-Emp., dated 21-07-1999, will be considered for absorption in regular establishments of the State Government against vacant Group-'D' posts, subject to their fulfilment of other conditions of recruitment.
- II. Attendants to Ministers/Ministers or State/Chief Govt. Whip, who were recruited on the basis of Home (C&E) Department Order No. 128-Home (Cons), dated 27-05-1999, and have not completed one year of continuous service yet, will be considered for absorption in the regular establishments of the State Government against vacancies in Group-'D' posts on completion of one year's continuous service, provided they fulfil other eligibility criteria for such appointment.
- III. Ministers/Ministers of State/Chief Govt. Whip will be entitled to appoint one more Attendant during their present tenure on receipt of fresh orders from the Home (C&E) Department of this Government.
