**Subject : Inclusion of some class of persons in the "Exempted Categories".**

In terms of this Department's Memo No. 300-Emp. dated 13.05.1985 and subsequent Memo No.350-Emp, dated 21.9.1990 such Election Job Workers'/Enumerators as were engaged by the Home(C&E) Department between 1979 and 1.6.1989 and who had put in a total of at least 240 days work during the said period were eligible for inclusion in the "Exempted Category" as enunciated in Memo No. 5120(60)-LW, dated 17.10.1977, read with Memo No.129(60)-LW, dated 25.1.1978 and No.130(60)-LW, dated 25.1.1978.

2. The question of extending the benefit of inclusion in the "Exempted Categories" to such Election Job Workers'/Enumerators as have completed 240 days work after 1.6.1989 had been under consideration of the Government for sometime in the past. After careful consideration of the matter, it has since been decided by the Government that the aforesaid benefit of inclusion in the "Exempted Categories" may now be extended to such Election Job Workers'/Enumerators as have completed 240 days' work upto 01.6.2000 and that further engagement of fresh hands in such work shall not be made by Home(C&E) Department.

3. In implementing the Govt. decision contained in this Memorandum all other conditions/guidelines embodied in Memo No.300-Emp. dated 13.5.85 and No.350-Emp. dated 21.9.90 shall be strictly followed by the concerned authorities.
